- Times for setup need to be booked ahead of time - email info@reptileexpo.ca
- Live inventory can be brought in Sunday morning.
- Setup will not permit drive in with vehicles - please bring carts/dollies to assist.
- No children on site during setup under the age of 14 years old.
- Sunday setup times 8 am to 9:30 pm.
- Exhibitors not abiding by these deadlines will forfeit their spaces and all payments.

Exhibitor Responsibility

- Exhibitors are responsible for wearing wristbands for security entrance.
- Exhibitors are responsible for providing a new unopened bottle of hand sanitizer on their table ready for use by 9:30 am day of show.
- Exhibitors are responsible to not pass around the handling of any live inventory outside of its presentation container.
- Exhibitor is responsible to ensure the public does not handle reptiles until the final sale transaction.
- Exhibitor is responsible to have no less than 100% Captive Bred live inventory on site.

Live Displays

- All live inventory must be packaged and displayed accordingly to not appear in undersized display presentation containers.
- Snakes must not be in a resting position touching more than two sides of the display.
- Snakes must not be in a resting position touching top and bottom of the display.
- All other reptiles, arachnids, amphibians must have enough space to completely turn around within the display.
- All live inventory that requires constant hydration must have access to clean water while on the event floor.
- All live inventory needs to be clearly labelled with the common name and/or Latin name.
- All live displays must not house more than one live inventory item in each deli style container.
- All live displays that house multiple live inventory individuals must allow enough space for all to move freely and comfortably.
- All live displays must be well ventilated.
- All live displays are to be clear and free of any external parasites, failure to do may result in the exhibitor being asked to immediately remove suspect individuals from the venue and site.
- All live inventory requiring a perch it is recommended to offer a secure perch of some type, this is the exhibitor's discretionary decision.



Please Note The Following New Specialty Pet Safety Elements Effective Immediately:

- A speciality pet veterinarian will be present at every show to ensure there are no signs of distress present in or events that do not fall within our vendor terms are addressed immediately.
- Our specialty pet veterinarian will be on site during set up and tear down.
- Exhibitors/vendors are requested to provide adequate heat to their displays that require above regulated venue temperatures.
- Led lights are prohibited for use with holding containers that can create any level of magnified light. Translucent displays are recommended.
- Species requiring constant levels of humidity or moisture must have access to water at all times at the booth - Spray bottle, bottled water etc.
- Substrates must be similar or equal to what is in regular use for the species.
- Substrate must cover the entire base of any holding/display unit.
- Substrates must be deep enough for species that prefer to nestle can do so.
- Floating or non fixed hides are not recommended.

Prohibited Species

- Any species of snake that will exceed the 3-meter rule as an adult.
- Any species of lizard that will exceed the 2-meter rule as an adult.
- All the species on the next two pages are not permitted to be on site.
